

Sample of a Pediatric SOAP note:

*Peds Progress Note – M3

S: significant events, concerns, problems in last 24 hrs, questions from pt or parent, sleep, diet, voiding, BM, flatus, amb, pain

O: VS Tm Tc HR current(range) RR cu(r) BP cu(r)
O₂ sat FiO₂

I/O 24 hr: In – PO: what & amount IV: what & amount
Out – Urine UOP = cc/kg/hr, # of Stools

8 hr: I/O

Lines, Tubes PIV, PICC, Broviac, Foley, NG, ostomy...

PE Gen: sleeping/awake, mood...

HEENT: NC/AT, PERRL, EOMI, OP-MMM

Neck: supples, ø LAD

Lung: CTAB, ø G/F/R

CV: RRR s M/R/G, nl pulses: (2+ DP)

Abd: soft, NT/ND, +BS, ø HSM

GU: (often “deferred)

Ext: ø C/C/E, WWP, CR<2 sec

Neuro: good nl tone..

Meds (name) [(dose) (route) (frequency)]

ABX – note #days completed

Note if some main med recently stopped

Labs/Studies (date)

Micro (date) Type Result Sensitivity

Other Studies (date) eg CXR:

A/P: Pt identified, hospital day/post-op day, diagnosis/assessment, significant new issues

Plans for each pertinent organ system

(CNS, Pulm, CV, FEN/GI, Heme, ID, Endo, Social)

Signature, M3/M4

Print name, pager #

Date and time

***Needs to be cosigned by resident or attending**

***Needs to be on chart before noon if possible so nurse manager can complete daily tasks**
