DIVISION DESCRIPTION

The Division of Pediatric Hospital Medicine provides exceptional coordinated, family-centered inpatient general pediatric care. The division also houses the Pediatric Complex Care Program, the Pediatric Diagnostic Referral Clinic, and participates in delivery of sedation services within American Family Children's Hospital.

Our scholarly work focuses on system improvements related to patient- and family-centered care, education in inpatient pediatric medicine, care of children with medical complexity and global health.

2017 HIGHLIGHTS

- Ann Allen, MD, was awarded a clinical teacher award from the UW Department of Family Medicine and Community Health's Madison residency program. She was also named the UW Department of Pediatrics' medical director for community hospital medicine.
- **Ryan Coller, MD, MPH,** was selected to serve as a member of the National Quality Forum's (NQF) Care Coordination Standing Committee for the Care Coordination Endorsement Maintenance Project.

He also received the UW Department of Pediatrics' 2017 Gerard B. Odell Research Award. This award, first established in 1994, is given to an assistant or associate professor in the department in recognition of outstanding research accomplishments and demonstrated potential for future contributions.
