

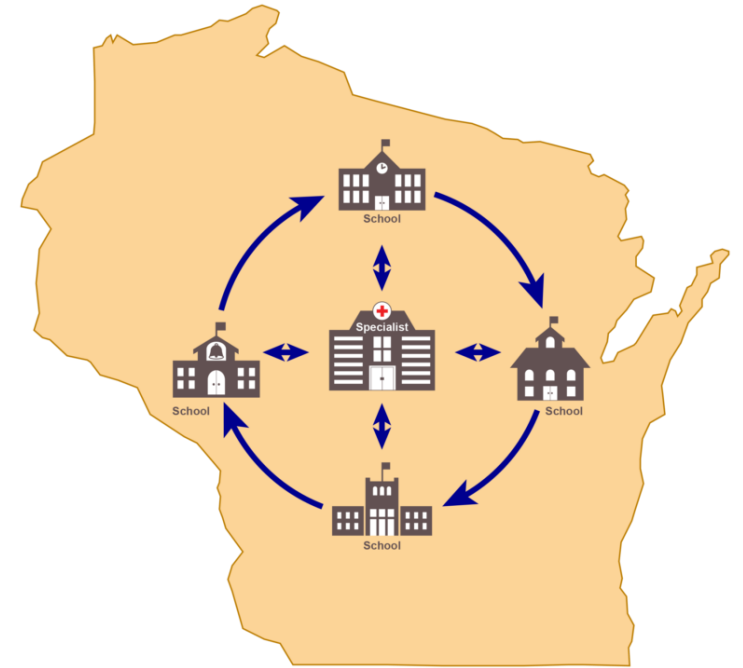

What do participants need to do?

Before the Session:
